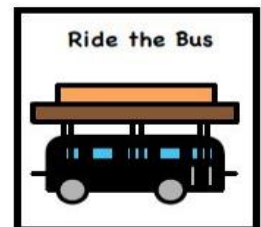

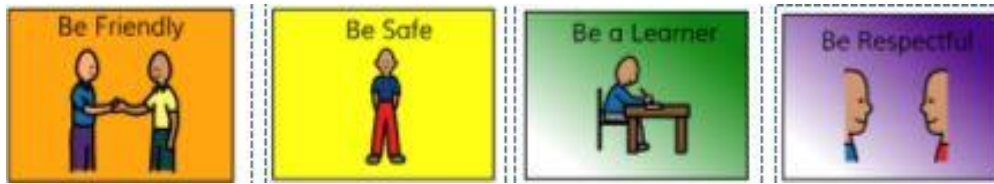

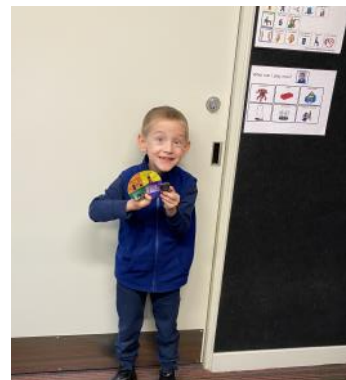


# Token Winners!

# Lunch box ideas

## Kid-Friendly Salmon and Sweet Potato Patties

Ingredients:

2 cups of sweet potato

1 cup of Frozen peas

1 can of Salmon drained (Large)

2 cups of Bread crumbs

4 Eggs lightly beaten

2 spring onions sliced

1 tbs oil



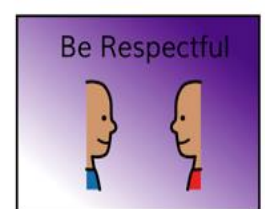
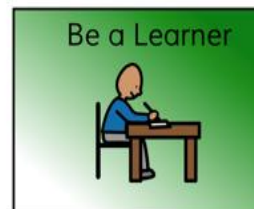
Boil, steam or microwave sweet potato and peas. Drain and mash potato, add peas.

Add Salmon, 1/3 of the breadcrumbs, spring onion to the sweet potato mixture and stir to combine.

Place the remaining bread crumbs on a plate.

Shape salmon mixture into patties and roll each in remaining breadcrumbs.

Heat oil in a frypan and cook patties in batches. Serve with salad leaves.

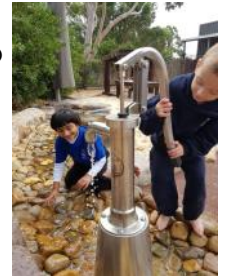


## NEW PLAYGROUND
