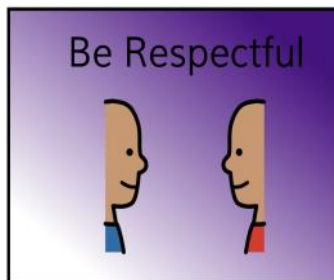
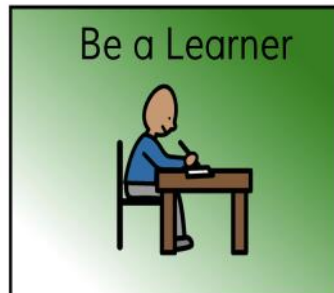

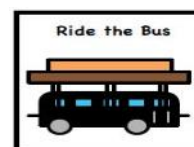

TUNA AND SALAD PINWHEELS

Multigrain wraps

Small avocado

Grated carrot

Cucumber cut into ribbons

Tuna in springwater

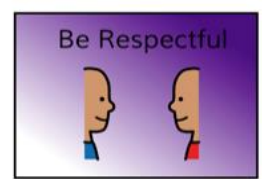
Shredded iceberg lettuce

Mayonaise



- Place 1 wrap on a board. Spread with half the avocado, leaving a 1cm border. Top with half the carrot, cucumber and tuna.
- Drizzle with half the mayonnaise and sprinkle with half the lettuce. Roll up wrap tightly to enclose filling. Trim ends (if using round wraps).
- Cut into 6 slices. Repeat with remaining wrap, avocado, carrot, cucumber, tuna, mayonnaise and lettuce
