

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

Lunch box ideas

Japanese Rice Balls

- 1/2 cup white jasmine rice
- 1/2 cup brown rice
- 1 tbs vegetable stock powder

Method:

Combine white and brown rice with stock powder and cook according to instruction on the packet of brown rice.

Mix the cooked rice with 2-3 of the suggested fillings of your choice.



Roll into small bite-sized balls and place into pattie cases.


Store in an airtight container in the fridge and use as needed.


Suggested Fillings:


