Lunch box ideas

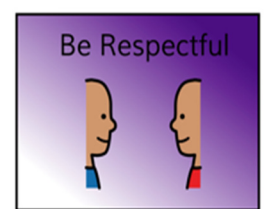
Mini Carbonara Quiches

80g dried spaghetti pasta
2 tsp Olive oil
150 g bacon, chopped
2 cloves garlic, finely chopped
2 eggs
1/2 c thickened cream
3/4 c finely grated parmesan



Pre heat oven to 180 degrees/160 fan forced. Grease a 6 hole muffin pan. Line muffin hole bases with baking paper. Cook the pasta in a large saucepan until just tender. Drain and transfer to a bowl. Meanwhile, heat oil in a frypan and add bacon and cook stirring occasionally. Add the garlic and cook, stirring for 30 seconds.

Add the bacon mixture to the cooked pasta. Use tongs to toss until combined. Divide among the prepared holes. Place the egg, cream and Parmesan in a jug and whisk to combine. Carefully spoon the egg mixture into the muffin holes. Bake for 17 minutes or until set. Set aside for 3 minutes to cool slightly.
