

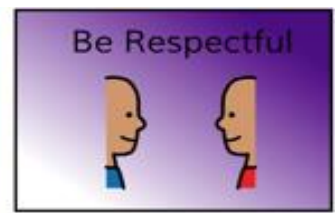

When I use the internet and ICT equipment at school, I agree to:

- Put my personal mobile phone away during the school day.
