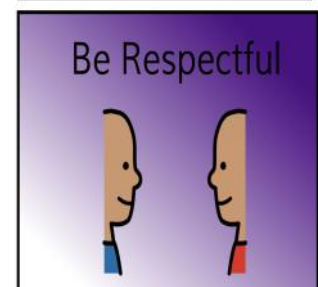
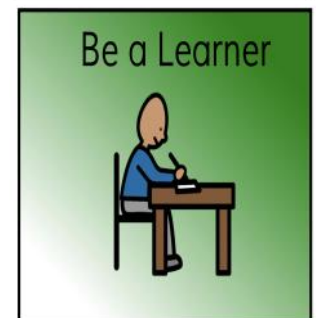


BUSH WALKING FOR ROOM 10

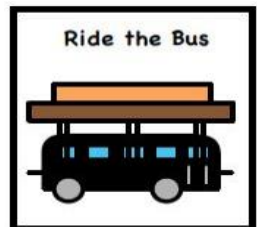

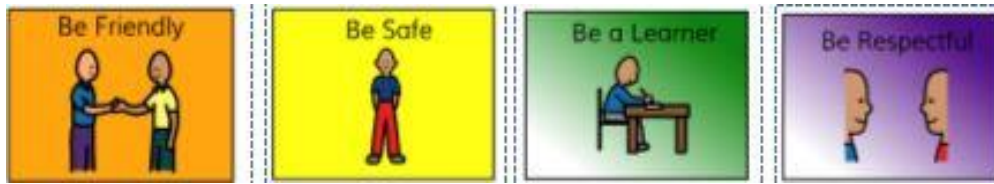

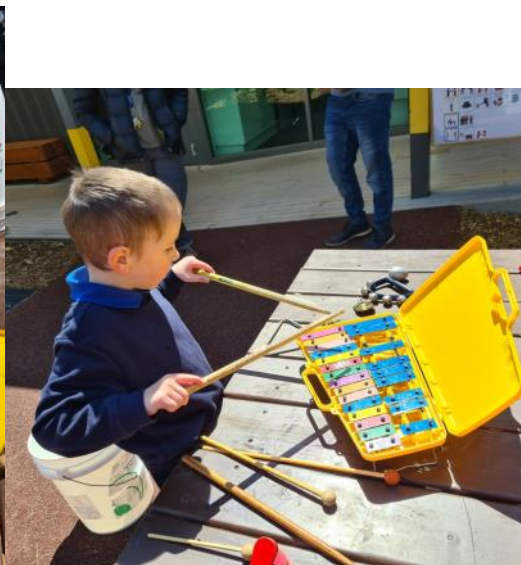
