GIPPSLAND TECH SCHOOL VISITS SGSS!






On Mondays, for three weeks, Gippsland Tech School will be visiting SGSS to teach students electronics and design-based skills.






Jazmin Magda won second place and a prize at the Korumburra Show last weekend for her wonderful art piece. Well done, Jazmin!
