



Sticky Chicken Recipe

Easy, 5 minute prep, 30 minute cook, 4 servings

Ingredients

- 8 Chicken thigh fillets
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- 1/2 cup sweet chilli sauce
- 1/2 cup crunchy peanut butter



Method

- 1. Mix all ingredients, except chicken in a saucepan over a low heat
- 2. Pour over chicken and let marinate for a few hours
- 3. Place chicken onto a tray lined with baking paper and bake at 180C for approximately 30 minutes.


