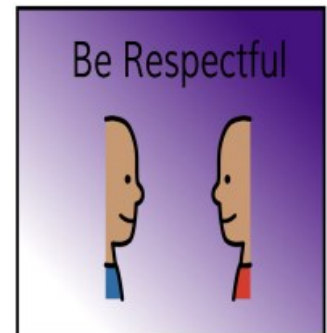
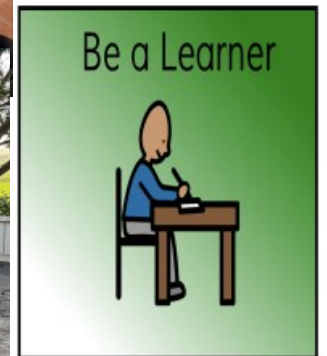

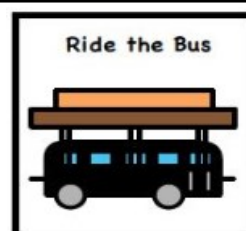

# SGSS Trivia Night

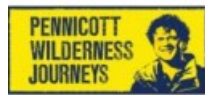
## 2nd September 2023

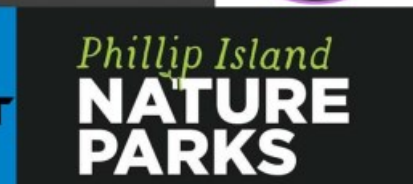

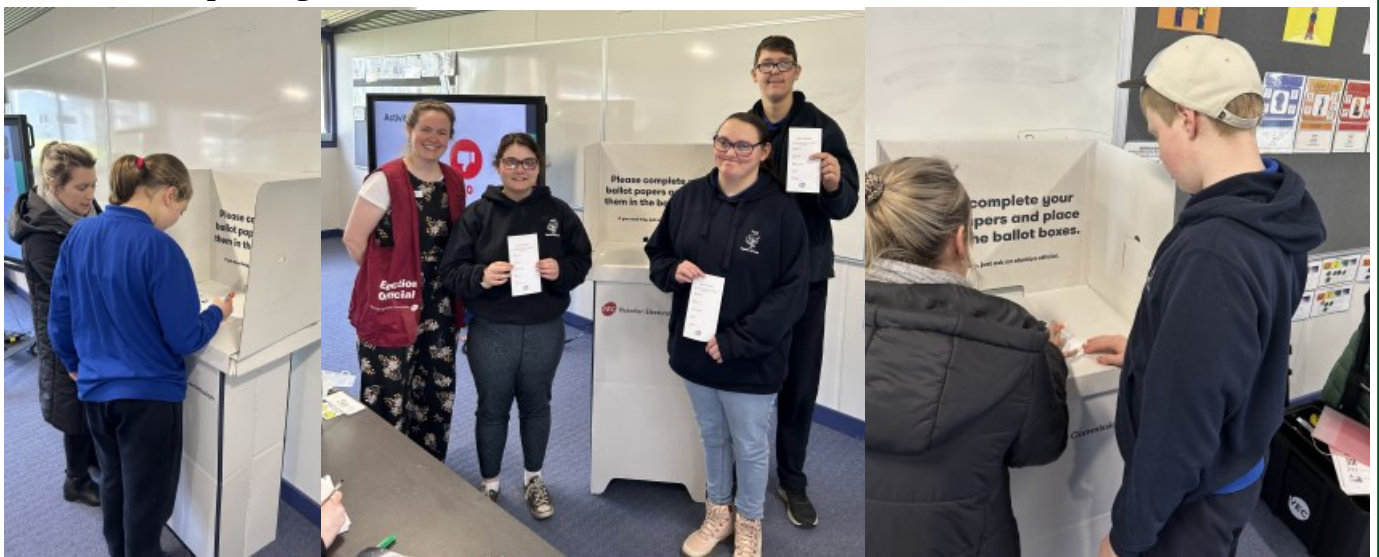

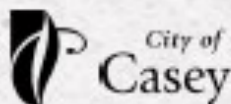
