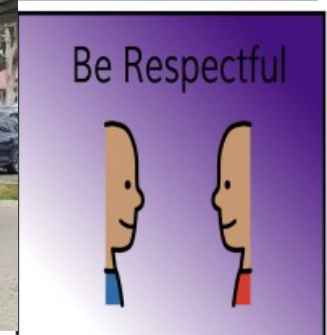
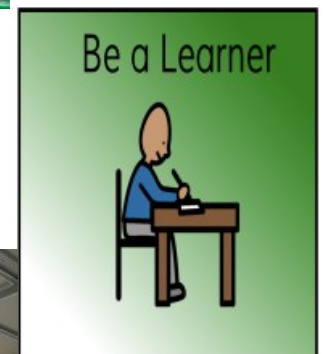

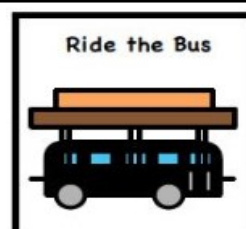

## San Choy Bau

### Ingredients

- 8 large iceberg lettuce leaves, washed (trim edges)
  - 2 tbsp plain, unsalted peanuts
  - 120g mushrooms, very finely sliced
  - 2 medium carrots, peeled and finely grated
  - 1 small brown onion finely chopped
  - 1 tbsp grated fresh ginger
  - ¼ cup coriander finely chopped
  - 1 2 tbsp reduced light soy sauce\*
- The Olive Tree Olive Oil Spray
  - 400g Ironbark Pork Mince
  - 50g bean sprouts
  - 3 large spring onions, finely chopped
  - 2 garlic cloves, crushed
  - 2 tbsp lime juice
  - 1 cup finely shredded green cabbage (or Chinese cabbage)
- \*Optional red onions. Cut onion in half and slice.



### 2 Method

1. Heat a wok over a medium-high heat until hot and spray with olive oil spray.
2. Add ginger, garlic and onion and stir-fry for up to 1 minute. Increase heat and add pork mince.
3. Cook the mince for approx. 4 mins, breaking up any chunks (or until changed colour and most of the moisture has evaporated).
4. Add remaining vegetables and stir-fry for 3–4 mins or until the vegetables have softened. Then add soy sauce\*, bean sprouts and lime juice. Stir fry mixture until well combined. Remove from heat.
5. Spoon mixture into the lettuce leaves and top with the peanuts and coriander as garnish to serve.
6. Serve immediately. \*Tip: if you prefer to use something other than a soy sauce reduction you can use Kecap Manis sauce.

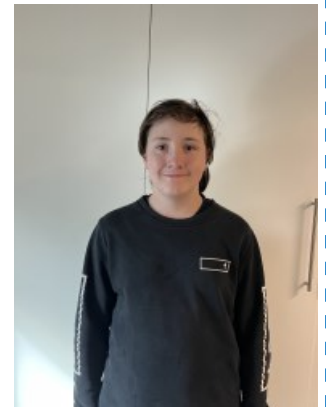

## FISH CREEK MOUNT OF OLIVES FARM



In the processing shed

In the olive grove watching how the olives are picked before they are made into oil !

The Sbat Program had a wonderful excursion to Fish Creek Mount of Olives farm on the 27/7/2023 . Students from both Bass coast and South Gippsland specialist schools were invited to see how olives are processed to make olive oil . We watched the pickers harvest the olives that are taken back to the processing shed . Here they were shown the whole process . The kids got to try oil coming directly from the processing machine . The 40 acre farm has 10,000 olive trees and this year it was a bumper crop . This liquid gold is sought after in this region and they are well known for their superior olive oil . The kids thoroughly loved the whole process and helped out in the processing shed . We look forward to more excursions like this to encourage our students and show them how wonderful the Agricultural/ Horticultural industries are and the opportunities they offer .
