Financial Support for Families

South Gippsland Specialist School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

• the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund

Families holding a valid means-tested concession card or temporary foster parents are eligible to apply. \$125 per year is paid for eligible primary school students, with \$225 per year paid for eligible secondary school student's. Payments are made directly to the school and are tied to the student.

• State Schools Relief

State Schools' Relief only responds to requests from schools and not from parents. The school will then make a request to State Schools' Relief on your behalf.
