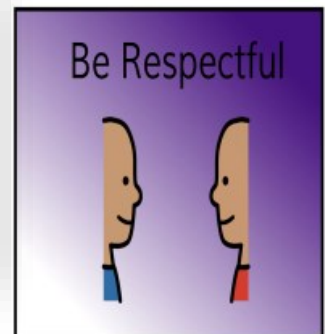
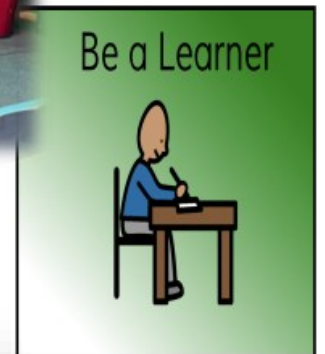

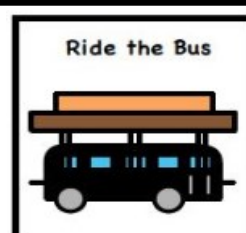

10 minute Fried Rice

Ingredients

- 1 tbsp peanut oil
- 250g pork mince
- 1 long fresh chilli
- 1 1/2 tbsp kecap manis
- 2 garlic cloves
- 1 tbsp light soy sauce
- 1 tbsp sweet chilli sauce
- 450g microwave jasmine rice
- 1/2 cup fresh basil leaves
- 110g frozen peas
- 2 eggs
- Fried shallots, to serve

Method

1. Heat oil in a wok over high heat. Add the pork and cook, stirring often, for 3 minutes or until browned.
2. While the pork is cooking, chop the garlic and chilli.
3. Push the pork to 1 side of the wok and add the garlic to the empty side. Cook garlic, stirring, for 30 seconds then toss into the pork. Add 1/2 tablespoon kecap manis and stir to combine. Cook, stirring, for 30 seconds or until caramelised. .
4. Use your hands to break up the **rice** in the packet. Add the rice and peas to the wok. Cook, stirring, for 30 seconds. Push the mixture to 1 side of the wok and crack the eggs into the empty side. Cook the eggs for 15 seconds then chop in the wok and toss through the rice.
5. Add the soy sauce, sweet chilli sauce and remaining 1tbs kecap manis to the wok. Toss to coat. Serve sprinkled with the basil, chilli and fried shallots.
