Healthy 3-ingredient banana mini muffins

Ingredients

- 2 medium bananas, mashed
- 180g (2/3 cup) thick and creamy vanilla yoghurt
- 150g (1 cup) self-raising flour

Method

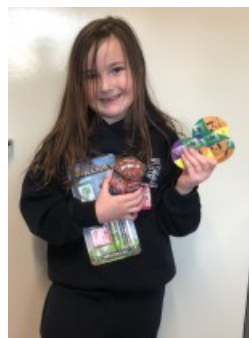
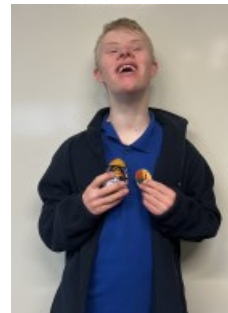
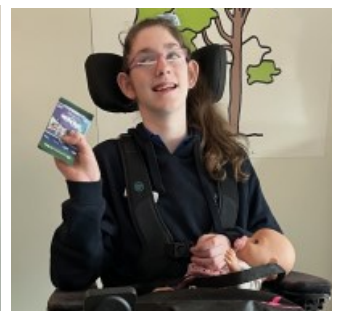
1. Preheat oven to 180C/160C fan forced. Grease a 24-hole mini muffin pan.
2. Combine yoghurt and banana in a large bowl. Gradually stir in flour until just combined.
3. Spoon mixture into muffin holes. Bake for 15 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean. Set aside in the pan for 2 minutes to cool slightly before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.
