Easy lamb and spinach Turkish pizza

1 Turkish Bread, split, base only

100g fetta, crumbled

200g beetroot tzatziki dip

Ingredients

- 500g Lamb mince
- 1 1/2 tbsp Moroccan seasoning
- 120g pkt Baby Spinach

Method

- Preheat oven to 200C. Heat a large non-stick frying pan over high heat. Cook mince, stirring with a wooden spoon to break up any lumps, for 5 mins or until mince is cooked through. Add the Moroccan seasoning and cook, stirring, for 1 min or until well combined. Remove from heat. Add half the spinach and toss to combine.
- 2. Place the bread base on a baking tray. Spoon over the mince mixture. Sprinkle with fetta. Bake for 15-20 mins or until bread is crisp and heated through.
- 3. Sprinkle remaining spinach over the pizza and top with dollops of tzatziki. Cut into pieces to serve.
