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Dear South Gippsland Specialist School families,

We are excited to inform you that commencing on Monday the 19th of February (Week 4 of Term), After School Care will be available on-site at your school, with on-site School Holiday Programs commencing in the upcoming Term 1 school holiday period. After School Care will run from 3:00pm to 6:00pm each school day (not including pupil-free days), while School Holiday Programs will operate from 9:00am to 5:00pm daily.

Due to funding from the Victorian Government, this program is entirely free of charge for families. There are limited places available.

Whilst attending the service, your child will be supported by trained educators at a high staff to student ratio, which we will determine in collaboration with yourself and the school, based on the needs of your child.

During After School Care, children attending will enjoy afternoon tea and take part in a range of planned activities, including art and craft, sport, creative play, cooking, construction and more, as well as free play, rest, and relaxation. School Holiday Programs feature a range of exciting excursions and incursions, as well as a variety of in-house activities.
